

Technical Bulletin 14-02, appendix 1 *Helmets and Facemasks - photos*

There are three helmet options for a Lacrosse player to use:

1. Field Lacrosse Helmet NOCSAE approved;
2. Hockey Helmet and Hockey face-mask Combo CSA approved;
3. Hockey Helmet and Lacrosse face-mask Combo CSA approved.

There are currently three CSA approved facemasks for lacrosse:

1. Marty O'Neill MX-13 Senior & Youth **(NEW)**
2. OTNY Junior & Senior mask
3. Gait G7 Senior & Junior

Please note that, effective January 1, 2014, the following policy is no longer valid:

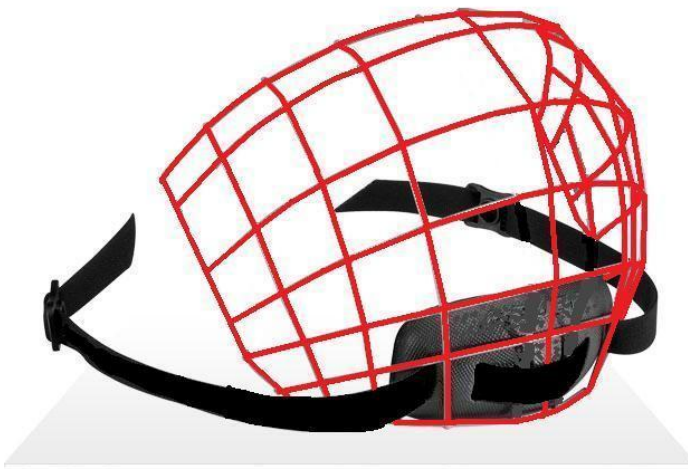
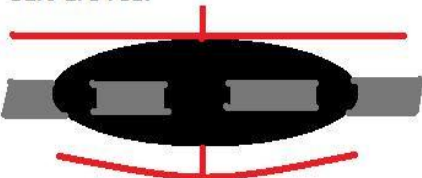
12.4.2.2.1 For the 2013 season, players in the senior age category, defined as "over 21" in 18.2 may use the non-CSA approved facemask that was approved for use in 2012;

The chin cup must be attached around the centre vertical bar at its lowest point and just above the lowest vertical bar on all face-masks. Never place a football style chin cup or any other chin cup that is not not manufactured for your face-mask onto your face-mask.

Note; the threading of the chin strap through the chin cup must be completed as above to meet CSA certification standards. The chin strap must ne attached to the sides of the helmet to meet CSA certification standards.

Chin Cup attached to the Mask, via straps, is attached onto the Helmet behind the ears.



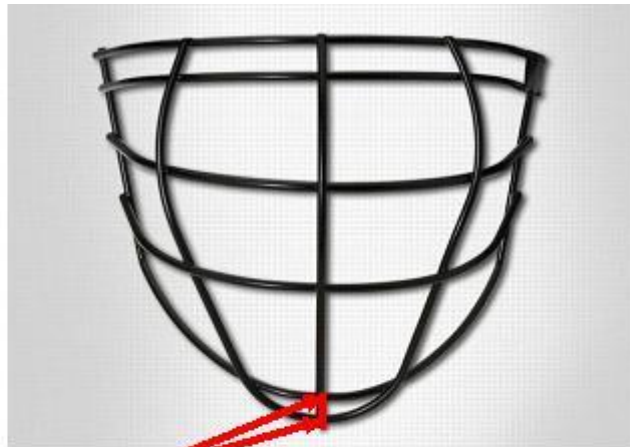
The original Chin Strap is attached to the helmet loops. It must be snugly secured under the chin with a general rule of no more than 1 index finger or 1" between the strap and under the chin.

Figure 2: OTNY Mask

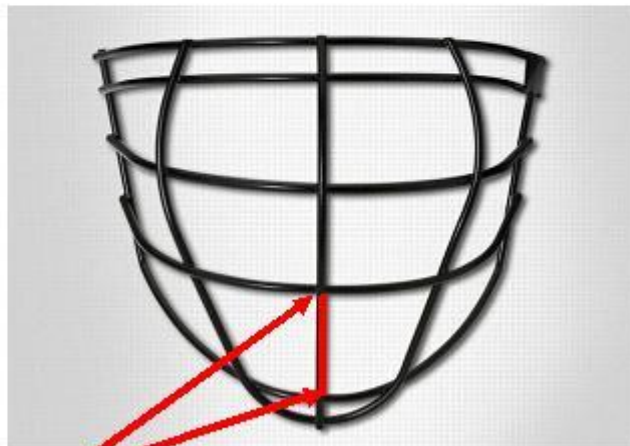
- To ensure a safe and proper installation the chin strap on the chin cup must be attached around the centre bar above the lowest horizontal bar and not in line with the bar closest to the mouth.
- The strap must wrap around the centre vertical bar shown in red.

- To ensure a safe and proper installation the chin strap on the chin cup must be attached around the centre bar above the lower bar of facemask and not in-line with the bar close to the mouth.
- The strap **MUST** wrap around the centre vertical bar shown in red.



- The strap **MUST NOT** wrap around the centre vertical bar above the second and third horizontal bars shown in red.
